If anything, in our era of visual overload, the freshness of how Monet saw the world is even more striking!	
6-9 July (Tues-Fri) <u>9AM-12PM</u> <u>OR 2PM – 4PM</u>	Artist Studied: <u>PAUL CEZANNE</u> . The French painter was one of the most important figures in the development of modern painting. In particular, the evolution of cubism and abstraction was largely due to his innovations. Dubbed the "solidifier of Impressionism", Cezanne created space and depth of perspective by means of planes of color, which are freely associated and at the same time contrasted and compared. The facets which were thus produced created not just one but many perspectives!
